This elderly housing contains three courtyards; two interior courts and one entrance court. The entrance court has been titled the 'Rose Court', reflecting the bronze rose bud sculpture by artist Keiko Nelson. Two smaller bronze rose sculptures are placed at the court entrance to emphasize the front of the project. The interior courtyards are laid out for seating and viewing from above. Each court has wood trellises to form outdoor rooms. Large pots are used for accent due to the fact that only nine inches of soil was used for the plantings. All the courtyards are on top of the parking structure below.
